Poke a hole in each container. Non-burnables Put glass panes, glass cups, and pottery in a bag. PET bottles Remove caps. (Caps shall be put out with the Plastic containers/packages.) Flourescent lamp tubes, light bulbs, and mercury thermometers are included in this category. Hazardous items Put dry batteries in the battery collection container.
