Dates of Garbage Collection in Your Area

Burnables	Twice a week on		and	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not put out metals, such as wire. ● Drain kitchen garbage well. ● The length of any item should not exceed 30cm. ● Please put out newspapers, magazines, cardboard, waste fabrics, and aluminium cans at regional locations for the collections of resources. 				

Non-burnables PET bottles Hazardous items	Once a month on		
Non-burnables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Completely empty spray cans and cassette-type gas bottles. Poke a hole in each container. ● Put glass panes, glass cups, and pottery in a bag. 		
PET bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remove caps. (Caps shall be put out with the Plastic containers/packages.) 		
Hazardous items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fluorescent lamp tubes, light bulbs, and mercury thermometers are included in this category. ● Put dry batteries in the battery collection container. 		

Glass bottles Cans	Once a month on		Wednesday
Glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remove caps and put into designated containers (transparent and colorless/brown/others. Cosmetics bottles can be put out, too. 		
Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cans of softdrinks, sweets, tea. Metal caps and lids are included in this category.
