Burnable Garbage



Tie the garbage bag tightly.

Garbage must be disposed of in city-designated garbage bags.

Large bag: 45 liters in capacity, up to 10kg in weight
Small bag: 25 liters in capacity, up to 6kg in weight

See the back of this leaflet for the list of shops that deal city-designated garbage bags.

※ The free burnable garbage disposal stickers provided to the households with newly born babies will be valid until March, 2026 (Reiwa 8).

Kitchen waste

Kitchen waste shall be well drained. (Make sure any remaining liquid is thoroughly removed before you put it out.)



Plastics and polyvinyl waste

Items (including hoses) should be cut into pieces **no larger than 30cm in length**. Garbage that contains **unremovably fixed metal** can be put out as this category. Detachable metal parts should be put out as **Non-burnable Garbage**.



※ The length of any item put into the garbage bag should not exceed 10cm.

※ Burnable garbage from business activities should be put out in a transparent bag with garbage disposal ticket for combustible garbage from business activities attached on it as before. (Up to 10kg a day)

Leather goods, shoes, sandals, and rubber items

Garbage that contains **unremovably fixed metal** can be put out as this category.



Beddings (futon), blankets and carpets

Cut into **30cm pieces** and put out in a garbage bag. (You can also put these out as bulky waste by booking a fee-charged door-to-door collection.)



Branches of less than 8cm in thickness

Cut into **30cm or smaller pieces** and put out in the garbage bag.



Non-burnable Garbage



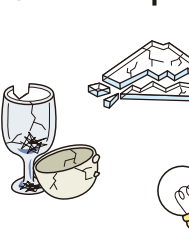
Tie the garbage bag tightly.

Garbage must be disposed of in city-designated garbage bags.

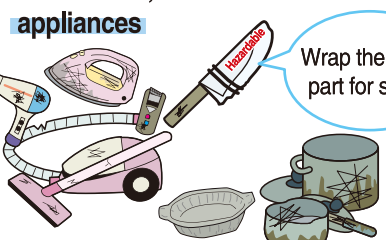
Large bag: 45 liters in capacity, up to 10kg in weight

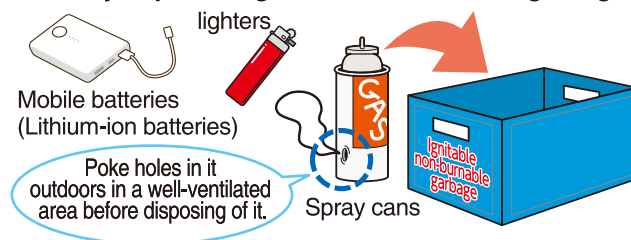
Metal items, small home electric appliances

The way to put out ignitable non-burnable garbage



Put items into the blue collection container without putting them in bags.

The way to put out non-burnable garbage that are too big to put in the designated garbage bag:

If a combustible item is too big to put in the city-designated garbage bag, please book a door-to-door bulky garbage collection. ※ You can disassemble the item and put out in the city-designated garbage bags. Make sure the garbage will not weight over 10kg.

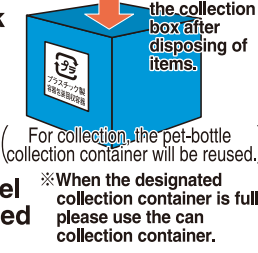


Plastic Bottles, Cups, and Trays (food product packing)

Plastic bottles, cups, trays, and packages that bear this plastic mark



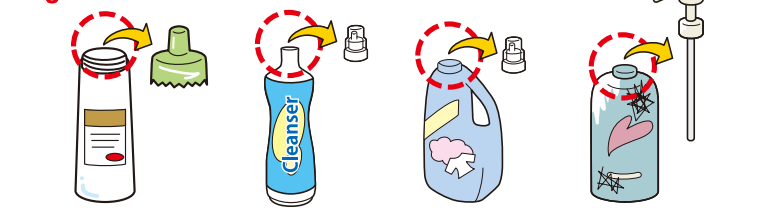
- Items with this mark shall be put out as this category.
- Empty and rinse inside.
- It is not necessary to remove every label and price tag attached on the item.



Put them into the designated container without wrapping or putting them in bags.

Bottles

Remove caps and nozzles and put them into the collection box together with the bottles.



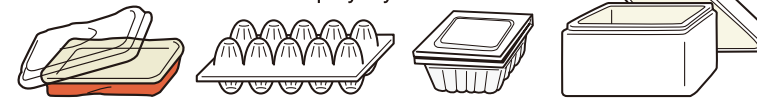
Cups

Remove the covers and put them out with burnable garbage. Paper cups should be put out with burnable garbage.



Food trays and cartons

It is not necessary to remove every label and price tag on plastic items. We only collect cushioning (packaging) materials made of foamed poly styrene.



The city does not collect waste from business activities.

Items that will not be collected as this plastic category

Burnable garbage

Items that cannot get cleaned
Tubes, snack bags, nettings, wrapping film, re-fill packages, plastic spoons and forks, straws, CD cases, laundry hangers, measuring spoons in laundry detergent package



Non-burnable garbage

Aluminum containers (e.g. 'nabeyaki-udon' noodle containers)



PET-bottles

Hazardous Garbage

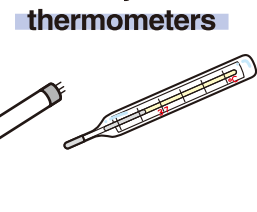
Separate the following items from other non-burnable garbage.

Put them into designated containers without wrapping or putting them in bags.

Fluorescent lamp tubes and fluorescent light bulbs

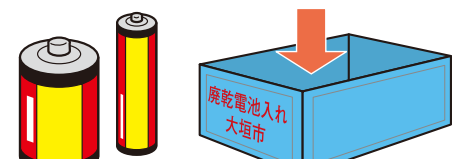
Incandescent light bulbs, night-light bulbs, grow lamps, and LED bulbs should be put as non-burnable garbage.

Mercury thermometers



Dry batteries

Used Ni-Cd batteries should be returned to the dealer.



PET-Bottles



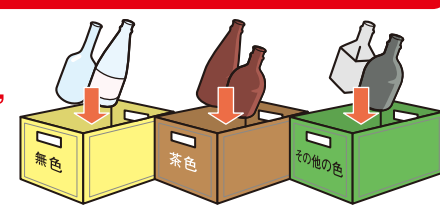
Bottles with this PET (Polyethylene Terephthalate) -Bottle mark
Please rinse before putting out.
Put them into the designated container without wrapping or putting them in bags.



Glass

- Empty and rinse inside lightly.
- Remove any caps, covers and spray nozzles.
- Put bottles into designated containers of each glass color. However, if you do not know which container to put them in, place them in the container labeled "Other colors".
- Beer bottles should be returned to the retailers.
- Cosmetic bottles are also collected as glass bottles.
- Put them into designated containers without wrapping or putting them in bags.

The city does not collect waste from business activities.

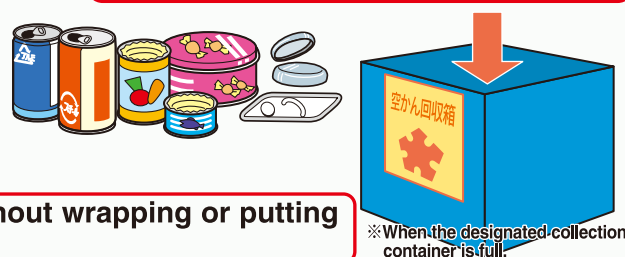


※ Milk-white glass bottles (e.g. skin cream bottles), glass bottles that contained agricultural chemicals, glass, ceramics, and glass tumblers/cups should be put out as non-burnable garbage.

Cans

- Cans that contained drinks and food
- Empty and rinse inside lightly.
- You can put out waste cans with a total length of up to 75cm, summing its width, length and depth.
- Metal caps and lids of cans shall be put out together with the cans.
- Put them into the designated container without wrapping or putting them in bags.

The city does not collect waste from business activities.



※ 18-liter cans, spray cans, kerosene cans, and paint cans should be put out as non-burnable garbage category.

Large-sized (Bulky) Waste Collection

Household items only. (Collection of bulky waste requires an advance reservation.)

※ Take the size of the furniture that is to be collected before you call.

2) Fees for the collection service

- Online payment of the fee is available for those who have made reservations via internet.
- Purchase a "Large-sized Waste Disposal Sticker"
Please buy a "Large-sized Waste Disposal Sticker", OGATA GOMI SHORI KEN, at convenience stores, super markets, or at the shop in the city hall. Write your name on the sticker and put it on the item to be collected, so that it can be seen clearly.
- Place the waste out at the designated pick up location by 8:30am.
 - Please place the waste in a safe place so as not to disturb other people or obstruct traffic.
 - You don't have to be present at the time of collection.

Disposal and collection of TV sets, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, and air conditioners.

Please use one of the following methods.

- Consult the retailer from whom you bought or replaced your appliance about disposal.
- Buy a recycling ticket at a post office, and take them to the following companies who pick up bulky waste.

- If you wish to apply for the city collection service, please buy a recycling ticket. Plus, you will be required to buy a "Large-sized Waste Disposal Sticker" (3,140 yen) per one item. Make a call to arrange the time and place of collection.

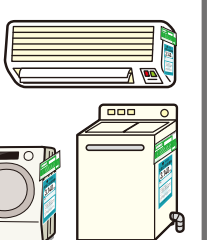


QR Code for the Large-sized Waste (Bulky Waste) Collection Reservation Website

The maximum weight to be collected at one time is 80kg per item, and the total weight is 200kg.



Please do not put anything inside the item to be collected.



Bringing in your household waste

If you wish to bring your household garbage or business garbage directly to the city's Refuse Disposal Center, contact us in advance.

Burnable garbage, carpets, futon beddings, mattresses (without springs)

- The facility where you bring in your waste: Refuse Disposal Center (8:30 ~ 16:30 on weekdays)
- You can bring in 20 futon (beddings) at most a day.
- Fees: 100 yen per 10 kg of waste

Large sized waste, non-burnable waste

- The facility where you bring in the waste: Seinanno Sodaigomi Shori Center (Address: Ario, Yoro-cho / Reception hour: 8:30 ~ 16:00 on weekdays)
- Fees: 1,000 yen up to 100 kgs of waste. Additional fee for waste over 100 kg: 100 yen per 10 kgs
- Note: Apply and get the waste checked at the Refuse Disposal Center, regional offices of Ogaki City

Cardboard, newspaper, magazines, other waste paper, milk carton

- The facility where you bring-in the waste: The city's Refuse Disposal Center, Seibu/Hokubu Civil Service Center, city regional offices.
- Request: Please put the same items in paper bags or bundle together with string.
- Put the items out at garbage collections organized by your community association or by PTA groups.

Glass bottles, cans, PET-bottles, plastic bottles/cups/trays, cooking oil

- The facility where you bring in the waste: the Recycling Center
- Request: Please divide by item and bring in. Make sure to divide glass bottles by color

Small size home electric appliances

- The facility where you bring in the waste: Refuse Disposal Center, city regional offices
- Request: Note that you cannot bring in a TV, a refrigerator, a freezer, a washing machine, a dryer for clothes, and an air conditioner. See the "Large-sized waste Collection" section.

Debris Make inquiries to the Refuse Disposal Center.

Request

Please put out the garbage by 8:30 AM on the designated collection dates.
When putting garbage (e.g.cans) in a specified collection box, do not wrap or put them in a bag.
