New Coronavirus Infection Control Measures at Evacuation Centers

Preparation at normal times / early evacuation

At an evacuation center, where many evacuees are accommodated, the risk of infection might increase.

Note the following and get ready for early evacuation at times of natural disaster.

- Check a chance of flooding and landslides around where you live.

 Have alternative places to evacuate to, including higher floors of
- your residence, residences of your friends/relatives, other than designated evacuation centers
- Prepare enough facial masks, antiseptic solution, soap, a clinical thermometer, and etc.
- Fill in the form 'Evacuee Personal Information' beforehand.

 Make sure you wear a facial mask, gargle, and wash hands thoroughly at an evacuation place.
