

New Coronavirus Infection Control Measures at Evacuation Centers

Preparation at **normal times** / **early** evacuation

At an evacuation center, where many evacuees are accommodated, the risk of infection might increase.

Note the following and get ready for early evacuation at times of natural disaster.

- ① Check a chance of flooding and landslides around where you live.
Have alternative places to evacuate to, including higher floors of
- ② your residence, residences of your friends/relatives, other than designated evacuation centers
- ③ Prepare enough facial masks, antiseptic solution, soap, a clinical thermometer, and etc.
- ④ Fill in the form 'Evacuee Personal Information' beforehand.
- ⑤ Make sure you wear a facial mask, gargle, and wash hands thoroughly at an evacuation place.
